Charles Grant M.A. (1807-1892)



Charles Grant was born at Knockando in Moray, and became a respected schoolteacher at Aberlour. He composed many strathspeys and reels and was a pupil of William Marshall the great composer of Scottish fiddle music. He played Marshall's favourite strathspeys to him on his deathbed and his family later bequeathed Marshall's violin to him in 1851.
